REPLY MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT OF MOTION TO UNSEAL; DECLARATION OF BENJAMIN M. CREPS; EXHIBITS "1" – "5"

#### REPLY MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT OF MOTION TO UNSEAL

This case is so thoroughly hidden from public view that non-party Movant Civil Beat Law Center for the Public Interest (Law Center) only knew the information in the Notice of Denied Access [Dkt. 70] when it filed the present motion (and that Notice is not even publicly accessible in the Court's record). This motion only seeks to unseal the initial pleading that started this action and the docket. Dkt. 72 at 2.1

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Because of the extreme secrecy surrounding this civil action, until the deputy attorney general provided a copy of the docket, as discussed below, the Law Center did not know that the action is an administrative appeal started by a "notice of appeal" rather than a "complaint".

After the Law Center filed the motion to unseal, counsel for Appellee State of Hawai'i Department of Human Services (DHS) provided the Law Center with a copy of the initial pleading (without attachments) and the docket. Declaration of Benjamin M. Creps, dated August 29, 2023 (Creps Decl.), ¶¶ 19 – 21; Ex. 4 (docket); Ex. 5 (notice of appeal). Based on a review of those documents, there is no "privacy" basis for continued sealing of the documents requested in the Law Center's motion. To the extent that attachments to the notice of appeal raise legitimate privacy concerns, the Law Center defers to the Court's review.²

The Law Center respectfully requests that the Court unseal, at a minimum, the notice of appeal without attachments and make the docket publicly accessible.<sup>3</sup>

## I. Responsive Facts

The Law Center filed its motion to unseal in this *civil* action because nothing was publicly accessible regarding this case. The judiciary's website for public access to court records, eCourt Kokua, indicates that this entire case is sealed; only the civil number is accessible. Ex. 2 (screenshots). That is how it appeared the day the Law Center requested access to the subject records, the day the Law Center filed its motion to unseal, and presently. Creps Decl.,  $\P\P$  10 – 11.

On June 20, the Law Center requested and was denied access to the court docket and complaint in this matter. Ex. 1 (clerk's denial). The clerk's denial identified "David

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> DHS mischaracterizes discussions with the Law Center regarding this motion in an effort to claim that the Law Center conceded that the requested documents are confidential. The Law Center has never conceded that documents that it has not seen are confidential and has been clear that the documents already provided by DHS to the Law Center do not seem justifiably sealed. Because DHS focused on those conversations, the Law Center provides more complete context in its accompanying declaration. Nevertheless, for purposes of this motion, the Law Center's statements in those conversations are irrelevant to whether compelling interests exist by law to support the continued sealing of the requested records.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup> Although the Law Center is not seeking to unseal other documents within the record, unsealing the docket will allow other members of the public to assert a right of access if warranted for other documents. *Hartford Courant Co. v. Pellegrino*, 380 F.3d 83, 93 (2d Cir. 2004) (constitutional access "would be merely theoretical if the information provided by docket sheets were inaccessible"); *accord* Dkt. 72 at 7 (citing cases).

Alan Lopez" as the Plaintiff and "Diane R. Corn, Hearing Officer et al." as the Defendant. *Id.* The clerk's denial also provided, "Under HCCR Rule 10.10, the requestor may make a motion to the court for access no later than ten (10) days after the denial of the request." *Id.* On July 27, the Law Center did just that.

The motion to unseal, filed pursuant to HCCR Rule 10.10, asked to unseal the complaint and court docket in this civil action. As noted in the motion, the Law Center filed its motion as an over-the-counter paper copy, not an electronic filing, so that it would not gain undue access to electronic case files, in compliance with HCRR Rule 10.4. Creps Decl.,  $\P \P 8 - 9$ .

On June 29 the court set the motion for hearing and directed the Law Center to file a notice of hearing. The Law Center did so that same day.

On several occasions *following* the filing of the motion to unseal, counsel for DHS contacted the Law Center regarding resolving the motion. Creps Decl., ¶¶ 12 - 28. On August 1, DHS informed the Law Center that it believed that Hawaii Revised Statutes chapters 350 and 587 justified closure. *Id.* at ¶ 14. That day, DHS and the Law Center discussed the potential of resolving the motion by way of stipulation. *Id.*; Ex. 3 (emails). Two days later, the Law Center identified to DHS several concerns regarding a stipulated resolution. Creps Decl., ¶ 16; Ex. 3 at 2. DHS replied on August 15, attaching a copy the petition (without exhibits) and court docket (a non-public screenshot). Creps Decl., ¶¶ 19 - 21; Ex. 4; Ex. 5.

- II. DHS fails to meet its burden to justify continued sealing of the initiating pleading (without exhibits) and case docket.
  - A. There is no public record that the procedural and substantive standard for sealing have been met in this case.

To justify keeping a court record sealed, a court must "make specific findings demonstrating a compelling interest, a substantial probability that the compelling interest would be harmed, and there is no alternative to [sealing the record] that would adequately protect the compelling interest." *Oahu Public'ns, Inc. v. Ahn*, 133 Hawai'i 482, 507, 331 P.3d 460, 485 (2014). "Requiring specific findings *on the record* enables the trial court to address each element necessary for closure and allows an appellate court

to review the reasoning of the trial judge to ensure that protection of the public right was adequately considered." *Id.* at 498, 331 P.3d at 476 (emphasis added); *accord Grube* v. *Trader*, 142 Hawai'i 412, 427, 420 P.3d 343, 358 (2018) (trial court's findings must be made with adequate specificity and "the trial court may not base its decision on conclusory assertions alone.").

While DHS alludes to the "existence of a carefully reviewed and argued motion on the issue of sealing the Circuit Court record," neither are available to the public and neither been provided to the Law Center. Thus, there is nothing in the public record to show that the procedural and substantive requirements under *Ahn* and its progeny were met when this case was initially sealed.

Additionally, the mere existence of a sealing order does not end the Court's analysis. The decision to continue sealing, when challenged, is a judicial act that must meet the relevant standards. *See generally Roy v. Gov't Emples. Ins. Co.*, 152 Hawai'i 225, 230, 524 P.3d 1249, 1254 (App. 2023) (granting motion to unseal years after entire court case was sealed); *Grube*, 142 Hawai'i at 427 n.20, 420 P.3d at 358 ("And, even assuming that procedural and substantive requirements to seal any of the documents had been met, the court should have scheduled periodic review hearings to determine whether the reasons justifying the sealing continued to apply."); *United States v. Antar*, 38 F.3d 1348, 1363 (3d Cir. 1994) ("From the record before us, the district judge appears not to have recognized that maintaining the transcripts under seal, though a passive act, was an active decision requiring justification under the First Amendment.").4

If there are sufficient facts and legal authority to seal the entire case, then at least that justification or some non-confidential portion of it should be public. That is the

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>4</sup> Moreover, the court rules contemplate revisiting orders sealing documents or entire cases. *E.g.*, HCCR Rule 10.4 (identifying parties permitted to access confidential records "except as otherwise provided by statute or court rule or as ordered by" a court of competent jurisdiction); Hawai'i Electronic Filing and Service Rules (HEFSR) Rule 8.1 ("Documents in confidential cases and documents submitted under seal or sealed by court order shall be maintained in JIMS under electronic security and made accessible to only the parties, the court, the appellate courts, and court staff until a court of competent jurisdiction orders otherwise.").

only way to ensure they are available for future scrutiny, since many bases for closure shift or fade over time.

B. As DHS apparently conceded in sharing the requested documents unsolicited with the Law Center, the constitutional right of privacy does not justify sealing the notice of appeal and the docket in the entirety.

The motion to unseal asks this Court to unseal two things: the complaint and case docket. These are records that DHS, through its counsel, has already disclosed to the Law Center—a disclosure that is plainly at odds with the position taken by DHS's written opposition.

The constitutional right of privacy is limited in its scope. The Hawai'i Supreme Court uses a two-prong constitutional inquiry to determine whether "the matter publicized is of a kind that (a) would be regarded as highly offensive to a reasonable person, and (b) is not of legitimate concern to the public." Pac. Radiation Oncology, 138 Hawai'i at 19, 375 P.3d at 1257 (referencing Restatement (Second) of Torts § 652D); SHOPO v. SPI, 83 Hawai'i at 398, 927 P.2d at 406. Even if disclosure of certain information might be "highly offensive to a reasonable person", that information is not "highly personal and intimate" under the Hawai`i Constitution if it is "of legitimate concern to the public." Pac. Radiation Oncology, 138 Hawai'i at 19, 375 P.3d at 1257. And in assessing whether a person has a reasonable expectation of privacy, courts consider whether the information is already in the public domain. Civil Beat Law Ctr. for the Public Interest v. City & County of Honolulu, 144 Hawai'i 466, 482, 445 P.3d 47, 63 (2019) (applying constitutional right of privacy) ("a person cannot claim a legitimate privacy interest in information that has already been made public."); accord In re Copley Press, 518 F.2d 1022, 1025 (9th Cir. 2008) ("Once information is published, it cannot be made secret again.").

Exhibits 4 and 5 confirm that the minimal requested unsealing—even for a sophisticated audience—will at most reveal that the plaintiff, a non-minor individual, filed an agency appeal involving a decision of an employee or agent of DHS. The subject matter of the appeal is not revealed. DHS cites no authority authorizing the sealing of an entire civil case based on these facts. The requested unsealing simply does

not present the privacy concerns alleged by DHS, given the actual contents of the court docket and notice of appeal.

Additionally, existing matters in the public record significantly diminish any privacy concerns relative to the limited unsealing requested by the motion. DHS fails to disclose that two family court TRO actions, and related appeal, involving petitioner Lopez are open, and extensive substantive portions of the court record in those matters are public. FC-DA No. 18-1-0235; FC-DA No. 18-1-0195; CAAP-18-0000451. This Court may take judicial notice of those records. HRE 201; *Uyeda v. Shermer*, 144 Hawai'i 163, 172, 439 P.3d 115, 124 (2019) ("The most frequent use of judicial notice of ascertainable facts is in noticing the contents of court records.").

The constitutional right of privacy does not justify sealing this case, the notice of appeal, or the docket in their entirety.

# C. DHS's claim of improper notice lacks merit.

DHS claims that the Law Center did not follow applicable rules regarding service of the Motion: "Movants are aware that their efforts to unseal this case are being done without proper notice to Mr. Lopez[.]" Opposition at 2. That is not true.

The Law Center filed the motion conventionally, as is required by the rules, and thus had no knowledge of all the parties or the identities of their counsel. Creps Decl.,  $\P \P 3-11$ . HCCR Rule 10.10 expressly provides: "The Clerk shall notify all parties of the motion."

Further, because this case docket is electronic, all counsel of record consented to electronic service of filings in this case, including the present motion. *E.g.*, HEFSR Rule 4.2 ("Where the registrant is an attorney, the registration shall include . . . acknowledgments that (a) the registrant consents to electronic notice in lieu of physical service of documents[.]"); Rule 6.1 ("The Notice of Electronic Filing automatically generated by JEFS and JIMS constitutes service of the electronically filed document to JEFS Users."); and Rule 6.3 ("The Notice of Electronic Filing automatically generated by JEFS is sufficient to show service on all JEFS Users and parties who have consented to receive service by electronic means."). As apparent from the docket provided by DHS

(Ex. 4), after the Law Center conventionally filed, the Clerk electronically filed the Law Center's motion to unseal, which provided notice to all parties.

## D. DHS identifies no statute requiring this entire case to be sealed.

DHS does not at all address the test required by the Hawaii Supreme Court for sealing matters. DHS claims merely that "this case would be sealed in all other Courts in the State of Hawai'i including the Family Courts, the Intermediate Court of Appeals, and the Supreme Court." Opposition at 2 – 3. DHS, however, provides zero authority for this assertion.

In discussions with the Law Center (but not its opposition), DHS relied on Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS) chapter 587A to support its position that the entire case must be sealed. But that chapter applies by its express terms to family court. HRS § 587A-5 (providing family court exclusive jurisdiction); see also HRS § 587A-4 (defining "court" as "one of the family courts established pursuant to chapter 571."). DHS cites no authority that makes HRS chapter 587A applicable to this Court.<sup>5</sup>

Additionally, while certain DHS reports and related records are confidential by law under HRS §§ 346-10, 350-1.4, 350-1.6, and Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR) chapter 17-601—none of these authorities support sealing *this entire case*, an agency appeal filed in the circuit court.

Although DHS claims that this Court thoroughly addressed sealing in a prior order, DHS did not provide a copy of that order to the Law Center. To the extent that this Court's initial sealing order in this case [Dkt. 25] provides further justification for the sealing, the Law Center would ask that the Court unseal that order so that the public can better understand the basis for sealing and permit the Law Center an opportunity to provide supplemental briefing, as appropriate, if the Court is inclined to deny the present motion.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>5</sup> If HRS ch. 587A applied to this proceeding, presumably the Court would have dismissed for lack of jurisdiction or otherwise explored transferring the matter to family court because family court has exclusive original jurisdiction over 587A proceedings. HRS § 571-11(9).

## E. Alternatives to sealing the entire case must be considered.

If there is a compelling interest that would be irreparably harmed by disclosure, redaction is an adequate alternative to concealing an entire document from the public. *E.g.*, *Ahn*, 133 Hawai'i at 507-08, 331 P.3d at 485-86 ("redacting personal identifiers or replacing any identifying information with a juror-number generally strikes the quintessential balance between preserving juror privacy and allowing public access to review trial proceedings for fairness and impartiality"); *accord Oahu Public'ns Inc. v. Takase*, 139 Hawai'i 236, 246-47, 386 P.3d 873, 883-84 (2016). Any denial of public access must be narrowly tailored so that it is "no greater than necessary to protect the interest justifying it." *Grube*, 142 Hawai'i at 427, 420 P.3d at 358.

In *Grube, Ahn*, and *Takase*, the Hawai`i Supreme Court emphasized that sealing court proceedings from public view must be "narrowly tailored to serve [a compelling government interest]." *Ahn*, 133 Hawai`i at 497, 331 P.3d at 475; *accord Grube*, 142 Hawai`i at 427, 420 P.3d at 358 ("The court should therefore make findings regarding specific alternatives and set forth its reasons for rejecting each."); *Takase*, 139 Hawai`i at 246-47, 386 P.3d at 883-84. In each case, the Hawai`i Supreme Court emphasized redactions as an appropriate alternative to sealing an entire document.

Here, everything is sealed, even the court docket. If legitimate privacy concerns persist, then there are lesser alternatives to protect privacy interests than sealing the entire case, such as redaction and sealing of sensitive information. DHS has failed to address any alternatives to complete closure.

#### III. Conclusion

The Law Center respectfully requests that the Court unseal the initial pleading filed in this case and the case docket.

## DECLARATION OF BENJAMIN M. CREPS

- 1. I, Benjamin M. Creps, am a staff attorney for Movant Civil Beat Law Center for the Public Interest (Law Center). I make this declaration in support of the Law Center's Motion to Unseal Court Records filed June 27, 2023 (Motion) and do so based on personal knowledge, the Law Center's business records, and public records.
- 2. I have reviewed the Department of Human Services (DHS) memorandum in opposition to the Motion and the supporting declaration of deputy attorney general Lynne M. Youmans, filed August 24, 2023 as Dkt. 77 (opposition).

## The Law Center's Request for Access to Court Records and Motion to Unseal

- 3. On June 20, 2023 I submitted a Request to Access Court Records (Request) that requested access to the complaint and case docket in this civil action.
- 4. Because nothing at that time was publicly available about the case, and because the Law Center had no idea what parties were involved, the Request indicated that the names of the parties were "unknown" to the Law Center.
- 5. On June 20, the same day I submitted the Request, the clerk of court denied the Request pursuant to Rules 10.4 and 10.10 of the Hawaii Court Records Rule (HCRR). A true and correct copy of the clerk's denial is attached as **Exhibit 1**.
- 6. The clerk's denial identified "David Alan Lopez" as the Plaintiff and "Diane R. Corn, Hearing Officer et al." as the Defendant. *Id*.

- 7. The denial also provided, "Under HCCR Rule 10.10, the requestor may make a motion to the court for access no later than ten (10) days after the denial of the request." *Id.* (emphasis added).
- 8. Less than ten days later, on June 27, 2023, I filed the Motion pursuant to HCRR Rule 10.10. As noted in the Motion, the Law Center filed it as an over-the-counter paper copy, not an electronic filing, in compliance with HCRR Rule 10.4. Motion at 2, fn. 1.
- 9. Electronic filing provides JEFS users with access to court records and information that may not be public, *e.g.*, "sealed" records. The Law Center did not have special JEFS access to any information in this case.
- 10. Attached as Exhibit 2 are true and correct screenshots of the judiciary's website for public access to court records, eCourt Kokua, indicating that this entire case is sealed; only the civil number is accessible.
- 11. Exhibit 2 accurately represents how the judiciary's public record of the above-captioned case appeared the day the Law Center requested access to the subject records, the day the Law Center filed the Motion, and presently.

## The Law Center's communications with the attorney general's office.

- 12. After the Law Center filed the Motion, it was contacted by the attorney general's office about the Motion.
- 13. Attached as Exhibit 3 is a true and accurate copy of email correspondence between myself and deputies attorney general James W. Walther and Lynne M. Youmans from August 1 to August 15.
- 14. As memorialized by Exhibit 3, deputy Walther and I spoke by telephone on August 1. In that phone call:
  - a. I asked deputy Walther to identify the legal authority that would make the above-captioned case confidential, and he generally identified Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS) chapters 350 and 587A;
  - b. I informed deputy Walther that the Law Center's priorities were unsealing the docket and a public explanation for sealing the case;

- c. We discussed the potential of a stipulation as an alternative approach to resolve the Motion; and
- d. We concluded the call with me informing deputy Walther that I would confer with my colleague and further consider the idea of resolving the Motion by way of a stipulation.
- 15. Deputy Walther and I exchanged confirmation emails after the above-described call, and deputy Walther informed me that deputy Youmans would be working on this case. **Exhibit 3** at 4.
- 16. After considering the practicalities of a stipulation further, I wrote to deputies Walther and Youmans on August 3 to identify concerns with a stipulated resolution and reiterated that "our primary objective is [to] ensure that the public has access to information that at the least explains why this case is sealed-off from the public in its entirety" and provided the Law Center's position that "[o]ur motion, related briefings, and the court's disposition is likely the best and most simple way to do that. We are not trying to unseal anything that is confidential by law." *Id.* at 2.
- 17. Within minutes of sending the above-described email, I sent a follow-up email further clarifying that "by docket, we do not mean all records within the docket. Just the docket itself the index of the case." *Id.* at 1.
- 18. I received no response to my August 3 emails until two weeks later, on August 15.
- 19. On August 15, deputy Youmans emailed me—unsolicited—a copy of the docket and the notice of appeal that initiated this civil action. Exhibit 3 at 1.
- 20. A true and correct copy of the docket sent to me by deputy Youmans is attached here as **Exhibit 4**.
- 21. A true and correct copy of the notice of appeal sent to me by deputy Youmans is attached here as **Exhibit 5**.
- 22. Upon receiving the email, I reviewed the attachments and noted that while the docket sheet identified some docket entries as "sealed", the vast majority were not so identified, and responded to the above email in substance as follows:

Thank you Lynne. That is helpful. Is there anything sensitive in the files that are not already marked as sealed? If not, why not just lift the confidential flag? The "sealed" files will remain sealed. I presume the attachments to the notice of appeal would be covered by the court's order sealing the circuit court record.

- 23. I did not receive any written response to my email.
- 24. Deputy Youmans and I spoke by phone late on August 16. Deputy Youmans seemed to be angry with me for filing the Motion—given my prior experience and communications with her office, I was very caught off guard by this.
- 25. After listening to Ms. Youmans speak for several minutes uninterrupted, I expressed my belief that she misunderstood the relief sought by the Motion and explained that I took exception to the assertion that the Law Center had done anything untoward in filing a motion that is permitted by court rules and founded on a constitutional right.
- 26. I am willing to answer any questions of the court or submit a more detailed recollection of that conversation should this Court deem it relevant.
- 27. In these post-motion communications with the attorney general's office, the Law Center attempted to explore solutions that might satisfy DHS's concerns while still comporting with the legal standards set forth by the Law Center's Motion—both as a matter of professional civility and also out of a desire to reduce any administrative burden that the Motion might place on this Court.
- 28. The Law Center has repeatedly explained to the attorney general's office that the objective is to ensure that, at minimum, an explanation for sealing this entire case is available to the public.
- I, Benjamin M. Creps, declare under penalty of law that the foregoing is true and correct.

Hi again. Without ruling out the idea completely, we've spotted a few concerns with trying to resolve our motion by stipulation:

- We don't know if and what the other parties will stipulate to.
- From our perspective, we'd also need to assure against somehow bargaining away or frustrating any rights of the public. (I understand that parties can't simply stipulate to what the law is in a manner that is binding on others, but am still wary of potential consequences I just don't see.)
- We obviously don't know anything really about this case or what's been filed with the court, so we'd be in the dark about the subject matter of any stipulation. (Whereas the court is not in the dark when deciding our motion.)

When you have a moment, take another look at what we request in the motion. It's pretty narrow - just asking to unseal the complaint and docket. I'd imagine the complaint could be redacted in a manner to satisfy confidentiality concerns (?), and then we'd need to discuss with the court the mechanics of how the docket might be unsealed while similarly addressing confidentiality concerns.

At bottom, our primary objective is ensure that the public has access to information that at the least explains why this case is sealed-off from the public in its entirety. Our motion, related briefings, and the court's disposition is likely the best and most simple way to do that. We are not trying to unseal anything that is confidential by law.
