Dear Judge Burgess:

Movant Public First Law Center writes to respectfully request that the Court unseal an additional document, Dkt. 288. Public First did not previously identify that document as part of its motion because it was not apparent from the more recent filings that it was relevant to the motions in limine. After reviewing the motions in limine unsealed on July 15, 2024, however, we noticed multiple citations, and incorporations by reference, to Dkt. 288. *E.g.*, Dkt. 422 at PageID.7861-67; Dkt. 423 at PageID.7874, 7878-82; Dkt 654 at PageID.10500 n.4.

On July 18, I asked counsel for the parties whether any had an objection to unsealing Dkt. 288. The Government—which had moved to seal Dkt. 288 when initially filed—responded: “The United States does not oppose the unsealing of docket entry 288.” The other parties did not respond.

Because no party has raised an objection, Public First would respectfully request that the Court unseal Dkt. 288.
